Fostering/adoptive parent form: Little paws to the rescue

In order to become a foster/adoptive parent, you will need to meet the requirements of the following:

- 1. Complete a foster parent or adoption form and contract, liability waiver and have a subsequent homevisit.
- 2. Homecheck forms, adoption forms, adoption contracts and all other paperwork is confidential to the potential adopter/foster home and the public.
- 3. Your own personal animals MUST be spay/neutered prior to fostering/adopting animals of the same species.
- 4. Understand that this is a commitment to Little paws to the rescue AND the pet(s) placed in your care.
- 5. Provide food,water and a safe, loving home for your foster(s) and/or adoption(s) where they can learn social behaviors they desperately need.
- 6. Temporary foster or foster to adopt or adoption, MUST bring animals to scheduled appointments!
- 7. You have read the additional forms necessary (i.e. Little paws to the rescue terms and conditions, animal care forms, etc.)
- 8. Before, during and after foster home/adoptive placement there will be pet evaluation and/or socialization visits to your house.

Agree and understand that Little paws to the rescue officers may also remove a foster/adoptive pet from a foster/adoptive home for any reason at any time deemed necessary. Ex: abuse,neglect or lack of food,shelter.
